





Institute of Piano, Organ, Sacred Music, Harpsichord and Early Instruments of the G. and K. Bacewicz University of Music in Lodz is pleased to announce that on November 19, 2021, an agreement was signed with the Faculty of Performing Arts, University of Stavanger, Norway, to implement the *Mobility in Higher Education* project under the Education Programme, *Component II*.

The implementation of the agreement allows student exchange (three 3-month mobilities) in the period from 16.08.2022 to 21.12.2022 (please, see the academic calendar of the University of Stavanger year calendar https://www.uis.no/en/inbound-exchange/academic-calendar)

The receiving institution undertakes to offer and implement a study programme that is individually determined for each student and described in a separate document (*Learning Agreement*).

As part of the project, participating students from Poland will receive funding for:

- travel expenses: 275 euros,
- stay costs (rate for 30 days of stay) 1,200 euros.

The agreement provides for the exchange of 3 students of majors conducted within the Institute of Piano, Organ, Sacred Music, Harpsichord and Early Instruments in the majors of Piano, Organ and Harpsichord at the G. and K. Bacewicz University of Music in Lodz. In case of lack of interest in the Programme among the indicated students, students from majors within the Faculty of Instrumental Performance will be eligible to participate in the Programme.

The main criteria for selecting students to participate are academic and artistic performance and English language skills.

The application form must be submitted on paper or electronically via email (a scan of the completed and signed document sent to international@amuz.lodz.pl) by February 22, 2022.
